Three Easy Ways to value your pieces.

2. Send us a photograph and a detailed description, (dimensions, condition, provenance, and any other pertinent information), either by e-mail, fax, or regular mail, so that we may make an approximate valuation. In some cases it may still be necessary to physically inspect the items.
3. In-home evaluation is available by appointment

Our commission rates are competitive and customary. Commission rates are determined at the time of valuation and may be determined in part by the value of the piece and/or the hammer price, (price realized at auction). The higher the value; the less the commission, and vice versa.
